CHORE CHART TEMPLATE INSTRUCTIONS

SUPPLIES

- 12 X 12 sheet of card stock/scrapbook paper. (As pretty or as plain as you'd like. You will be using both sides of the paper, so if you want a design on the whole chore chart, use a double sided paper.)
- Pen/Pencil
- Ruler
- Paper cutter
- Scissors
- Glue or Mod Podge (I love my Mod Podge)
- Adhesive Magnet strip
- Chore Chart Template Sheets

INSTRUCTIONS

Take your 12 X 12 card stock and measure 5 inches from the bottom. Draw a light line with a pencil across the paper. This will be used as a guide.

Starting from the edge of the paper, make a mark every two inches across the paper below the 5 inch line.

Using your paper cutter, cut from the bottom of the paper to the 5 inch line at every 2 inch mark. You should have 6 stripes or rectangles hanging from your paper at the 5 inch mark. Fold each 2 inch rectangles at your 5 inch mark.

Cut 12 magnet pieces from your magnet strip about 3/4 an inch to an inch wide.

Place a magnet on the inside end of each rectangle strip as well as where the rectangle strip hits the other side of the paper.

Cut a magnet strip about 2-3 inches wide and place on the back of the top of your chore chart.

You have now created your chore chart.

Next, using the template sheets, cut out the 6 "DONE" labels and glue them to the front of each rectangle strip.

Pick what heading you want from the list of headings and glue it to the top of your chore chart.

Pick the 6 chores you want to add to the chart and glue them on the inside of each rectangle flap so that when you open the flap, you see the chore pictures. Hang on fridge, or wherever you like!

HOW TO USE THE CHORE CHART SHEETS INCLUDED

I included a few different chore sheets according to your preference. I included cut lines on some of the labels so you know exactly what size to cut to fit on your template best.

There are several different titles to choose from. Is this a chore chart for bedtime, morning, extra chores? You can label them as such.

There are 3 different types of chore sheets

- 1. Blank Chores: There are just chore pictures to cut and use as you wish.
- 2. Blank Chores with Cut lines: There are chore pictures with a blank space for you to label your own chores and cut lines so you can cut the right size.
- 3. Labeled chores with cut lines: These chores are labeled with about 35 different chores and cut lines, so you can cut the right size.
